

## Free from Fear and Full of Joy!



A time of total chaos and the greatest holocaust in history is coming soon to the whole world, including the United States of America, exactly as prophesied in the Bible. In fact, prophesied wars that affect the whole planet, global pestilences (pandemics), food shortages (famine), and natural disasters that precede that time of “great tribulation” have already begun and are rapidly increasing in scope and magnitude.<sup>1</sup>

But, without denying that reality, we can be totally free of confusion, doubt and fear about the future and, in fact, be filled with the Spirit of joy, peace, love, and “great expectations” of life in the wonderful world to come—what the Bible calls Paradise.<sup>2</sup>

Here’s how:

According to current events in the light of Bible prophecy, the globalists, their communist proxies and other destroy-America groups are about to take over this nation. And, when they do, ALL AMERICANS (except globalists, communists, and their slaves) WILL DIE.<sup>3</sup>

After the U.S.A. can no longer interfere and some other intervening prophesied events occur, those same globalists and their proxies, led by “the beast” (the false messiah or Antichrist) will take over virtually the whole world.<sup>4</sup>

That’s the bad news.

The Good News is that we do not have to be afraid of the soon-coming Great Holocaust. In fact, believe it or not, exactly the opposite of how the unbelieving world will increasingly react in unbearable fear,<sup>5</sup> we can look forward to it with great joy. Here’s why: Elohim, the God of the Bible, has promised His people a place with Him in the wonderful World to Come—Paradise. His

Paradise will be the earth restored to its original, Garden of Eden-like beauty and perfection—unimaginably more wonderful than this present, evil, rapidly-deteriorating world.<sup>6</sup>

But, there's a catch. We have all sinned and fallen short of the perfection and glory of God.<sup>7</sup> So, spiritually, we are separated from Him.<sup>8</sup> And, He will not accept anything or person that is imperfect or corrupt into His Paradise.<sup>9</sup> Plus, there is nothing we can do to make up for or pay the penalty for our sins. That's because the penalty for sin is death.<sup>10</sup> So, no matter how much we attempt to pay in penance or how many good deeds we do, we can't even begin to pay what we owe the perfectly good, righteous, pure Creator and King of the universe.

However, the Good News (Gospel) is that from the beginning of His creation, Elohim had a plan for getting paid what we owe Him and redeeming us from the wickedness in which we are trapped. And that was to send His Son Yeshua the Messiah ("Jesus Christ") to earth to pay the penalty by sacrificing His own life on our behalf. Yeshua was the only one who could do that because, like His Heavenly Father, He was perfect in goodness and righteousness—the perfect, unblemished "Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world."<sup>11</sup>

And, just like His Father, because He loved us so much, Yeshua did that: He gave up His glorious beauty and majesty, and His heavenly powers – His omnipotence and omniscience – was born as a human being, subject to all the frailties, growth pains, learning curves, temptations, and suffering to which we humans are subject, with one exception – He never compromised His holiness – He never gave in to temptation and sinned. He was perfectly righteous and morally pure His whole life. And so, when He suffered and died on that cruel, Roman cross, His sacrifice of Himself was accepted on our behalf by His Heavenly Father. And eternal life with Him and His Father was credited to our heavenly bank account.<sup>12</sup>

However, there is a condition for withdrawing eternal life from our heavenly bank account. We have to admit that our sins have separated us from our God, reject and turn away from those sins (repent), and run to Him to replace those sins with His eternal life-giving Spirit of love, joy, peace, and faithfulness.<sup>13</sup>

It's not instantaneous. It will take the rest of our lives for our souls to be completely cleansed of the disgusting corruption that is in them, for that corruption to be totally replaced with the wonderful, pure, loving, and joyful Spirit of our Heavenly Father and Savior, and for us to attain glorious, sinless perfection.<sup>14</sup> But, the moment we repent of our sins and turn to Him believing that our sins are forgiven, trusting Elohim for our new life in the Messiah, we become new creations in Him and the process of perfecting us in Him begins.<sup>15</sup>

On the other hand, major change can happen rapidly. That's the voice of experience. Once the writer of this message was graciously convinced by the Holy Spirit that he needed to absolutely surrender every aspect of his being—body, mind, soul, and spirit—to his God and Savior in repentance, prayer, fasting, study and meditation on Scripture, and obedience to the Word (the Bible) and the Torah ("law") of Yehovah ("the LORD") which was written on his heart,<sup>16</sup> and he did that, the Holy Spirit took over and revolutionized his life. He was given a new heart of freedom

from doubt, anger, fear and sin, and filled with love, joy, peace, and “great expectation” of life with his Lord in the wonderful world to come that totally removed all fear of what will happen to him in this life and after this present life on earth is over.<sup>17</sup>

If it hasn't already, the same can happen to you. In these days of rapidly increasing hatred, lies, corruption, violence, and loss of property and lives, a Spirit of peace, love, joy, and hope that you never dreamed possible can fill your soul and actually make you look forward to getting this old life full of tribulation and suffering done with and to being with your wonderful Lord and Savior in your new, eternal home in His Paradise.

So, if you haven't done so already, repent of your sins that separate you from your God and Savior and put yourself totally in His hands for freedom from fear and regret, a heart full of love, joy, and peace, and the salvation of your soul.
